**AWARDING BID FOR A CLASS A URBAN INTERFACE PUMPING ENGINE
WITH MOUNTED AND LOOSE EQUIPMENT TO
KOVATCH MOBILE EQUIPMENT CORPORATION t/a KME FIRE APPARATUS**

WHEREAS, the Township of Upper Deerfield advertised bids with respect to one Class A Urban Interface Fire Truck Pumping Engine with mounted and loose equipment; and

WHEREAS, bids were received on May 4, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Kovatch Mobile Equipment Corporation t/a KME Fire Apparatus has submitted a low bid in the amount of \$385,719 which bid does not include any trade in value for a 1979 Continental Triple Combination Pumping Engine; and

WHEREAS, the bids have been reviewed by the Township of Upper Deerfield and Kovatch Mobile Equipment Corporation t/a KME Fire Apparatus is deemed to be the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield is desirous of awarding a bid to Kovatch Mobile Equipment Corporation t/a KME Fire Apparatus as aforesaid in the amount of \$385,719 not including trade in value for a 1979 Continental Triple Combination Pumping Engine; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement in form satisfactory to the Township Solicitor to the Township of Upper Deerfield with Kovatch Mobile Equipment Corporation t/a KME Fire Apparatus in the amount of \$385,719 for the purchase of one Class A Urban Interface Fire Truck Pumping Engine model year 2009 built on an International 4 x 4 four door chassis; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that this bid is in compliance with the provisions of Pay to Play, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5, et seq., in that the bids were publicly advertised, received and awarded; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contractor shall be required to comply with the filing of CR 271 at least ten days prior to the execution of a contract; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that bid bonds may be returned to unsuccessful bidders;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that a copy of this Resolution shall remain on file with the Clerk of the Township of Upper Deerfield and available for public inspection and notice of the award of bid printed in the official newspaper of the Township of Upper Deerfield.
