

TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD

RESOLUTION 10-175

**AMENDING PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT
WITH TRIAD ASSOCIATES**

WHEREAS, there exists a need for professional services to provide consulting, planning and administrative services for a SHARE (Sharing Available Resources Efficiently) Program Grant with Upper Deerfield Township serving as the host agency for the grant on behalf of the Governing Bodies of the Cumberland County Townships of Commercial, Deerfield, Downe, Fairfield, Greenwich, Hopewell, Lawrence, Maurice River and Stow Creek, the Borough of Shiloh and the City of Bridgeton; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Upper Deerfield has advertised Requests for Proposals for providing consulting, planning and administrative services for a SHARE (Sharing Available Resources Efficiently) Program Grant; and

WHEREAS, Triad Associates was awarded a contract in the amount of \$39,900 to prepare a SHARE (Sharing Available Resources Efficiently) Program Grant; and

WHEREAS, the NJ Department of Community Affairs has amended the grant by awarding an additional \$5,000 to the Township, due to the inclusion of the City of Bridgeton into the SHARE (Sharing Available Resources Efficiently) Program Grant Study; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield is desirous of amending the contract with Triad Associates to an amount not to exceed \$44,900 on behalf of the consortium of municipalities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Mayor and the Township Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to amend and execute an agreement with Triad Associates for a SHARE (Sharing Available Resources Efficiently) Program Grant with Upper Deerfield Township serving as the host agency for the grant on behalf of the Governing Bodies of the Cumberland County Townships of Commercial, Deerfield, Downe, Fairfield, Greenwich, Hopewell, Lawrence, Maurice River and Stow Creek, the Borough of Shiloh and the City of Bridgeton, for an amount not to exceed \$44,900.00
2. That the allegations of the preamble hereto are incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
3. That the aforesaid contract is awarded pursuant to competitive bidding as a "Professional Service" under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law because N.J.S.A.40A:11-5 states that no local unit shall be required to advertise for bids for services rendered or performed by a person authorized by law to practice a recognized profession and whose practice is regulated by law, or to advertise for bids for services which are of such a qualitative nature as will not reasonably permit the drawing of specifications or the receipt of competitive bids, all of which classification the aforesaid contract falls within.

4. A copy of the agreement has been filed with the Township Clerk and is available for public inspection in the office of the Township Clerk during normal business hours.
5. That a copy of the specific items pertaining to the award of this contract shall be published in a Notice of Award in the News of Cumberland County as required by law within ten (10) days of the Resolution authorizing same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that this professional service agreement is awarded pursuant to and subject to the provisions of Pay to Play legislation, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4, et seq.
