**APPROVAL OF CHANGE ORDER #2-
CONSTRUCTION OF NEW SEABROOK WATER TREATMENT FACILITY**

WHEREAS, a contract was awarded in the amount of \$2,544,000.00 to by Clyde Lattimer & Son Construction Company, Inc, for the construction of a new well #17 for the Seabrook Water System, together with radium removal and treatment plant for existing well #15 as well as well #17, as well as bids for the removal and disposal of spent media and furnishing and installing new media, provision of treatment for up to 1.5 billion gallons of water; and

WHEREAS, the contract amount was adjusted by a change order authorized by Resolution 10-152 with the final contract amount adjusted to \$2,569,234.00; and

WHEREAS, the design engineer and superintendent of water have recommended a change of the interior gate valves from Non-Rising Stem to Rising Stem and there is a need to get an analysis of the quality of water for existing well #15 and new well #17 to determine if there are any other treatment requirements for the facility; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has recommended such work for this project; and

WHEREAS, funds are available and have been certified by the local finance officer; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a change order in the amount of an increase of \$6,360.00 to the contract between by Clyde Lattimer & Son Construction Company, Inc, and the Township of Upper Deerfield to provide for the additional work is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the final adjusted contract amount is hereby approved as \$2,575,594.00.
