HONORING ANTHONY CUSANO

WHEREAS, Anthony Cusano, of 25 Johns Way in Upper Deerfield Township started in the Boy Scouts in South Carolina, before moving to Northeast Maryland and becoming a member of Troop 132, his family moved to New Jersey in 2005 and he joined Troop 98; he graduated from Cumberland Regional High School in 2011 where he received a varsity letter in soccer, was a member of the Honor Society and involved in various school clubs and activities; currently Anthony attends Cumberland County College; and

WHEREAS, Anthony is a member of Boy Scout Troop #98 where he has been working on becoming an Eagle Scout through the rigorous and demanding commitment required of the Scouting Program which leads to such designation after completion of earning the required 21 merit badges and providing various active leadership services including Senior Patrol Leader and presently serving as Assistant Scoutmaster for his Troop; and

WHEREAS, Anthony has successfully completed his service project by organizing and implementing a Coat Drive from November 2010 through January 2011 at the St. Vincent DePaul Society, where they collected over 500 coats to distribute to the needy residents in the greater Bridgeton area; and

WHEREAS, only two percent of the boys entering the scouting program achieve the rank of Eagle Scout with Anthony attaining his Eagle Scout designation on March 13, 2011; and

WHEREAS, on Sunday, November 6, 2011, Anthony Cusano, having faithfully completed his services and tasks, will be conferred the title of Eagle Scout in a Court of Honor ceremony held at Gia's Caterers, 36 Mulford Drive in Bridgeton at 1:00 pm.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield, in the County of Cumberland, that Anthony Cusano be commended for his achievement in obtaining Scouting's highest order; and
