**AUTHORIZING PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT
MV ENGINEERING – ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR CONTRACT COORDINATION
AND CONSTRUCTION OBSERVATION FOR THE REPAIR OF LOVE LANE**

WHEREAS, the Township of Upper Deerfield is in need of services of a professional engineer with respect to coordinate and observe construction of the repair of Love Lane between Silverbrook and Silver Lake Roads; and

WHEREAS, the award of a professional service agreement to a member of a qualified profession is exempt from the bidding requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield is desirous of retaining MV Engineering as a professional engineer with respect to coordinate and observe construction of the repair of Love Lane between Silverbrook and Silver Lake Roads; and

WHEREAS, MV Engineering is a qualified Professional Engineer licensed in the State of New Jersey to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, funds are available and have been certified by the local finance officer; and

WHEREAS, MV Engineering has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that MV Engineering will not make any reportable contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A.19:44A-1 et seq. commencing January 1, 2012 to any political committee or candidate through the term of this contract in excess of reportable limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that MV Engineering be and is hereby retained as a professional engineer on behalf of the Township of Upper Deerfield with respect to coordinate and observe construction of the repair of Love Lane between Silverbrook and Silver Lake Roads for the purposes expressed herein for an amount not to exceed \$12,150.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that this professional service agreement is awarded pursuant to and subject to the provisions of Pay to Play legislation, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5, et seq., in that the contractor has agreed to execute the Pay to Play exemption certification and has or will certify that the contractor has not during the last 12 months preceding the award of this contract nor during the succeeding 12 months contributed or will contribute campaign contributions in excess of reportable limits in accordance with the aforesaid legislation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution shall be published in the official newspaper of the Township of Upper Deerfield.
