HONORING KOREY LECHNER

WHEREAS, Korey Lechner, of Upper Deerfield Township started in the Boy Scouts on February 28, 2007, when he joined Troop 1; he graduated from Cumberland Regional High School in 2012, where he received an achievement letter and various awards, was a member of the National Honor Society, Latin Honor Society, Tri-M Music Honor Society, Marching Band, Concert Band, Latin Club, Book Club and Psychology Club; and as a recipient of New Jersey Stars will be entering Cumberland County College in the fall to attain his Associates Degree with plans to continue his education at a four year college majoring in botany; and

WHEREAS, Korey is a member of Boy Scout Troop #1 where he has been working on becoming an Eagle Scout through the rigorous and demanding commitment required of the Scouting Program which leads to such designation after completion of earning the required 21 merit badges and providing various active leadership services including Senior Patrol Leader for his Troop from January 2010 until February 2012; and

WHEREAS, Korey has successfully completed his service project by organizing and constructing a 2' by 24' footbridge for the "long trail" at Parvins State Park; and

WHEREAS, only two percent of the boys entering the scouting program achieve the rank of Eagle Scout with Korey attaining his Eagle Scout designation on February 15, 2012; and

WHEREAS, on Friday, August 3, 2012, Korey Lechner, having faithfully completed his services and tasks, will be conferred the title of Eagle Scout in a Court of Honor ceremony held at First Presbyterian Church, West Commerce Street in Bridgeton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield, in the County of Cumberland, that Korey Lechner be commended for his achievement in obtaining Scouting's highest order; and
