RESOLUTION 12-195

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR PRELIMINARY EXPENSES FOR CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITION TO THE AMBULANCE BUILDING IN THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD, COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Local Finance Board, by regulation, permits municipalities to fund preliminary surveys, architects’ fees, engineering costs, etc. from the Capital Improvement Fund provided that the ultimate project could be funded by a bond ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the construction of an addition to the ambulance building is a bondable capital improvement with a useful life that exceeds the minimum of five (5) years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield, County of Cumberland as follows:

Section 1. The Township Committee hereby establishes in the General Capital Fund an account designated “Reserve for Preliminary Expenses – Construction of Addition to Ambulance Building” in the amount of \$18,500.00.

Section 2. That all related services and costs could result in a project that would be bondable pursuant to NJSA 40A:2-1 et. seq., having a useful life of not less than five (5) years.

Section 3. Upon completion of the project, any unused funds in said Reserve shall be returned to the Capital Improvement Fund.
