**RESOLUTION 12-290**

**APPROVAL OF CHANGE ORDER #1 SMALL CITIES-CONYERS-MASON**

**WHEREAS**, a contract was awarded by Resolution 12-202, in the amount of \$21,695.00 to H.J. Graber, Inc., for rehabilitation work to the home of Sonya Conyers-Mason under the Small Cities Home Rehabilitation Program; and

**WHEREAS**, after further review of the basement windows and screen door the contractor and applicant determined that the basement windows and screen door, should be replaced at a cost of \$1,050.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the contractor and applicant have also agreed to remove the installation of one large replacement kitchen window for a credit of \$800 from the original contract and add the repair and installation of a floor covering in a hallway at a cost of \$800 to the original contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township’s Officials have recommended such work for this project; and

**WHEREAS**, funds are available and have been certified by the local finance officer.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that a change order in the amount of an increase of \$1,050.00 for repairs to the basement windows and screen door, installation of floor covering in the hallway and elimination of one large replacement window to the contract between H.J. Graber Inc. and Sonya Conyers-Mason to provide for the additional work is hereby approved; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the final adjusted contract amount is hereby approved as \$22,745.00; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of the resolution be given to the Treasurer and finance office.
