**SUPPORTING THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
TO CREATE A “NO PASSING ZONE” ALONG ROUTE NJ 77**

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) recently completed a traffic investigation on Route NJ 77 in Township Upper Deerfield, County of Cumberland; and

WHEREAS, NJDOT recommends a revision to the centerline pavement markings on Route 77 to create a “No Passing Zone” in the vicinity of Route NJ 77 in the vicinity of M.P. 3.3 to 3.5 (Love Lane) and M.P. 6.6 (Southbound only) for safety reasons; and

WHEREAS, this project will create safer driving conditions in this area of Route NJ 77;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Upper Deerfield Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield of, County of Cumberland, in the State of New Jersey, that it supports the use of a “No Passing Zone” on Route NJ 77 in the Township of Upper Deerfield as recommended by NJDOT.
