

**TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD**

**RESOLUTION 15-72**

**AUTHORIZING PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT  
PENNONI ASSOCIATES – SEABROOK SEWER MAINS TOPOGRAPHIC SURVEY**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Upper Deerfield is in need of services of a professional engineer with respect to topographic survey services for the Sanitary Sewer System in Seabrook from Highway 77 and Parsonage Road to the Cumberland County Utilities Authority pump station behind the Township's Convenience Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the award of a professional service agreement to a member of a qualified profession is exempt from the bidding requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.); and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Upper Deerfield received proposals from Fralinger Engineering in the amount of \$10,350, Pennell Land Surveying in the amount of \$18,500 and Pennoni Associates in the amount of \$4,800; and

**WHEREAS**, Pennoni Associates submitted the lowest responsible proposal and the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield is desirous of retaining Pennoni Associates as the professional engineer to provide survey services for the Sanitary Sewer System in Seabrook from Highway 77 and Parsonage Road to the Cumberland County Utilities Authority pump station behind the Township's Convenience Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Pennoni Associates is a qualified Professional Engineer licensed in the State of New Jersey to provide such services; and

**WHEREAS**, funds are available and have been certified by the local finance officer; and

**WHEREAS**, Pennoni Associates has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Pennoni Associates will not make any reportable contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A.19:44A-1 et seq. commencing January 1, 2015 to any political committee or candidate through the term of this contract in excess of reportable limits.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that Pennoni Associates be and is hereby retained as a professional engineer on behalf of the Township of Upper Deerfield with respect to survey services for the municipal complex for the purposes expressed herein for an amount not to exceed \$4,800.00; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that this professional service agreement is awarded pursuant to and subject to the provisions of Pay to Play legislation, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5, et seq., in that the contractor has agreed to execute the Pay to Play exemption certification and has or will certify that the contractor has not during the last 12 months preceding the award of this contract nor during the succeeding 12 months contributed or will contribute campaign contributions in excess of reportable limits in accordance with the aforesaid legislation; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That a copy of the specific items pertaining to the award of this contract shall be published in a Notice of Award in the South Jersey Times South as required by law within ten (10) days of the Resolution authorizing same.
