

Steve Smith – commented that recently spoke with Mr. Daddario on the Munyon property maintenance plan and Mr. Daddario, Mr. Rogers, and myself are continuing to mow the perimeter which everyone is comfortable with for now. The snow fencing comes in 50ft lengths at \$1700.00 with fencing and posts for the installation. Mr. Peterson suggested looking into getting old phone poles to create a barrier from vehicle access but the wildlife would still be able to access and only foot traffic could access the site as well.
