

**TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD**

**RESOLUTION 10-101**

**REDUCING TAX LEVY OF THE  
CUMBERLAND REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT 2010-11 BUDGET**

**WHEREAS**, the Cumberland Regional School District submitted to the voters on April 20, 2010 a General Fund Tax Levy of \$7,594,435.00 for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, of which the Upper Deerfield Township share was \$2,603,428.91, and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed General Fund Tax Levy was defeated by the combined vote of the seven constituent districts of the Cumberland Regional School District, and

**WHEREAS**, governing body representatives of the seven constituent districts of the Cumberland Regional School District have met and agreed that certain line items within the proposed budget need to be adjusted; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the position of the Upper Deerfield Township Committee to reflect the wishes of the electorate by reducing educational costs without adversely affecting the Cumberland Regional School Districts Board of Education's ability to provide a thorough and efficient education.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that the Township Committee does hereby certify a reduced budget amount for the 2010-2011 school year for the Cumberland Regional School Districts Board of Education as follows;

1. The original tax levy for the base budget on the ballot defeated by the voters of the Cumberland Regional School District was \$7,594,435.00, of which Upper Deerfield Township's share was \$2,603,428.91
2. The amount of reduction to the tax levy for the base budget proposed by the governing body representatives of the seven constituent districts is \$225,000.00
3. The amount of tax levy being certified by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield for the base budget is \$7,369,435.00, of which Upper Deerfield Township's share is \$2,526,297.24 for the 2010-2011 fiscal year.
4. The specific line item reductions and or increases in budgeted revenues for each change are as follows:

The Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield further certifies that the revised budget is and would be sufficient to provide a thorough and efficient education to the students of the Cumberland Regional School District.
