**EMERGENCY TEMPORARY RESOLUTION
PRIOR TO ADOPTION OF THE BUDGET
TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD, COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND**

WHEREAS, an emergent condition has arisen with respect to the acquisition of an emergency vehicle and for upgrade of the master plan. No adequate provision has been made in the 2010 temporary budget for the aforesaid purpose, and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for the creation of emergency temporary appropriations for the purpose above mentioned, and

WHEREAS, the total emergency temporary resolutions adopted in the year 2010 pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20, including this resolution, total \$370,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20:

1. An emergency temporary appropriation be and the same is hereby made in the total amount of \$370,000.

2. That said emergency temporary appropriation will be provided for in the 2010 budget as follows:

Current Fund:

Planning Board

Master Plan Upgrade \$ 20,000

Purchase of Emergency and Fire Vehicles \$ 350,000

3. That one certified copy of this resolution be filed with the Director of Local Government Services.
