

TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD

ORDINANCE 680

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF
CAPITAL RESERVE FUNDS FOR FARMLAND PRESERVATION AND OPEN SPACE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield, in the County of Cumberland and the State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The improvement described in Section 2 of this Ordinance is hereby authorized as a general improvement to be made or acquired by the Township of Upper Deerfield, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey to be funded by the Capital Reserve Funds.

- Section 2. (a) The improvement hereby authorized is the purchase of development easement which conforms to the Township farmland preservation plan
(b) The estimated cost of said purpose is \$21,385.00 and is hereby appropriated from the following funds;

Reserve for Purchase of Farmland and Open Space	\$ 21,385.00

Section 3. The following matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated;

- (a) The said purpose described in Section 2 of this Ordinance is not a current expense and is a general improvement which the Township of Upper Deerfield may lawfully acquire.
(b) The period of usefulness of said purpose, within the limitations of the local bond law and according to the reasonable life thereof, is at least five years.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect after final passage.
