RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF SHILOH

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield has determined that is advisable and beneficial to the residents to the Township of Upper Deerfield to enter into a shared service agreement between the Borough of Shiloh with respect to the services of the Borough’s Certified Recycling Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, shared services are permitted under the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield has reviewed the form of a shared services agreement between the Borough of Shiloh and the Township of Upper Deerfield for the aforesaid purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield is desirous of approving and entering into the aforesaid agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that a shared service agreement between the Borough of Shiloh and the Township of Upper Deerfield be and the same is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute the aforesaid agreement on behalf of the Township of Upper Deerfield; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that the agreement shall be deemed to be effective commencing on April 19, 2012.
