HONORING KASEY S. LECHNER

WHEREAS, Kasey S. Lechner, of Upper Deerfield Township started in the Boy Scouts on February 29, 2008, when he joined Troop 1; he graduated from Cumberland Regional High School in 2013, where he was a member of the National Honor Society, Latin Honor Society, Marching Band, Concert Band, Latin Club; and as a recipient of New Jersey Stars entered Cumberland County College in the fall of 2013 to attain his Associates Degree in Environmental Science; and

WHEREAS, Kasey is a member of Boy Scout Troop 1 where he has been working on becoming an Eagle Scout through the rigorous and demanding commitment required of the Scouting Program which leads to such designation after completion of earning the required 21 merit badges and providing various active leadership roles which included serving as Leave No Trace Trainer and as an Assistant Senior Patrol Leader for his Troop; and

WHEREAS, Kasey has successfully completed his service project by creating tree and plant identification signage at Parvin State Park; and

WHEREAS, only two percent of the boys entering the scouting program achieve the rank of Eagle Scout with Kasey attaining his Eagle Scout designation on September 11, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, June 7, 2014, Kasey S. Lechner, having faithfully completed his services and tasks, will be conferred the title of Eagle Scout in a Court of Honor ceremony held at First Presbyterian Church, West Commerce Street in Bridgeton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield, in the County of Cumberland, that Kasey S. Lechner be commended for his achievement in obtaining Scouting's highest order; and
