RESOLUTION 14-61

**AUTHORIZING PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT - FRALINGER ENGINEERING
BOUNDARY SURVEY OLD LANDFILL ON WOODRUFF ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Township of Upper Deerfield is in need of services of a professional engineer to complete a boundary survey at the old landfill on Woodruff Road; and

WHEREAS, the award of a professional service agreement to a member of a qualified profession is exempt from the bidding requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Township of Upper Deerfield received proposals from Fralinger Engineering in the amount of \$6,845, Adams Rehmann & Hegan in the amount of \$8,475 and Pennoni Associates in the amount of \$7,195. Tedesco Engineering did not submit a proposal; and

WHEREAS, Fralinger Engineering submitted the lowest responsible proposal and the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield is desirous of retaining Fralinger Engineering as the professional engineer with respect to complete a boundary survey at the old landfill on Woodruff Road; and

WHEREAS, Fralinger Engineering is a qualified Professional Engineer licensed in the State of New Jersey to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, funds are available and have been certified by the local finance officer; and

WHEREAS, Fralinger Engineering has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Fralinger Engineering will not make any reportable contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A.19:44A-1 et seq. commencing January 1, 2014 to any political committee or candidate through the term of this contract in excess of reportable limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that Fralinger Engineering be and is hereby retained as a professional engineer on behalf of the Township of Upper Deerfield to complete a boundary survey at the old landfill on Woodruff Road for the purposes expressed herein for an amount not to exceed \$6,845.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that this professional service agreement is awarded pursuant to and subject to the provisions of Pay to Play legislation, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5, et seq., in that the contractor has agreed to execute the Pay to Play exemption certification and has or will certify that the contractor has not during the last 12 months preceding the award of this contract nor during the succeeding 12 months contributed or will contribute campaign contributions in excess of reportable limits in accordance with the aforesaid legislation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution shall be published in the official newspaper of the Township of Upper Deerfield.
