RESOLUTION 15-313

AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY - TIMMONS

WHEREAS, Romane T. Timmons, property owner of 36 Quail Ridge Drive, Block 1105 Lot 24, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began June 1, 2015 and the homeowner purchased the property on October 13, 2015 which will require a refund in the amount of \$1,468.68 for the 80 days of exemption for calendar year 2015; and

WHEREAS, due to his disability, Mr. Timmons has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259, which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes in the amount of \$1,468.68 based on the exempted amount of the assessed value of \$48,900 of the current year's annual assessment of \$223,200, will be waived due to the exemption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 19th day of November, 2015, that the property located at 36 Quail Ridge Road, Block 1105 Lot 24 in the Township of Upper Deerfield have the assessed value of the property exempted in the amount of \$48,900 of the property's annual assessment of \$223,200 for calendar year 2015, and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of October 13, 2015; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is authorized to issue a property tax refund to Romane T. Timmons in the amount of \$1,468.68 to cover tax payments made in the 4th quarter of 2015 for the aforementioned reasons.
