RESOLUTION 18-170

AMENDING THE SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF BRIDGETON FOR USE OF THE CITY’S JET VACUUM TRUCK AND OPERATOR

WHEREAS, shared services are permitted under the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A.40A:65-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 13-218 authorized the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield to enter into a shared services agreement with the City of Bridgeton, with respect to the use of the City's Jet Vacuum Truck and operator for the maintenance of Storm Drains and Sewer lines; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield is desirous of approving the request from the City of Bridgeton to amend the fee for the use of the City's Jet Vacuum Truck and operator from \$86.00 per hour for regular hours to \$110.00 per hour and \$165.00 per hour for overtime hours.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that a shared service agreement between the City of Bridgeton and the Township of Upper Deerfield be amended to increase the fee for the use of the City's Jet Vacuum Truck and operator from \$86.00 per hour for regular hours to \$110.00 per hour and \$165.00 per hour for overtime hours and the same is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute the aforesaid amended agreement on behalf of the Township of Upper Deerfield; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that the agreement shall be deemed to be effective commencing on August 1, 2018.
