**RESOLUTION 18-183**

**SMALL CITIES FACILITIES GRANT TO REMOVE ARCHITECTURAL BARRIERS THAT RESTRICT ACCESS OF THE ELDERLY AND HANDICAPPED WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP RECREATION COMPLEX TO COMPLY WITH THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Upper Deerfield desires to apply for and obtain a grant from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs for up to \$400,000 to carry out a Fiscal Year 2019 Public Facilities project to remove architectural barriers that restrict access of the elderly and handicapped within the Township Recreation Complex to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,**

1) that the Township of Upper Deerfield does hereby authorize the application for such a grant, and,

2) recognizes and accepts that the Department may offer a lesser or greater amount and therefore, upon receipt of the grant agreement from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, does further authorize the execution of any such grant agreement; and also, upon receipt of the fully executed agreement from the Department, does further authorize the expenditure of funds pursuant to the terms of the agreement between the Township of Upper Deerfield and the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs; and
