RESOLUTION 18-211

**AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A
WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY - HOLT**

WHEREAS, Edward Holt, property owner of 112 Landis Ave, Block 2401, Lot 16, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

WHEREAS, due to his disability, has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began on July 24, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the property taxes for the 3rd and 4th quarters 2018 in the amount of \$3,151.04, and the 1st and 2nd quarters 2019 will be waived due to the exemption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 4th day of October 2018, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$101,800 and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of July 24, 2018; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is authorized to waive the property taxes for the 3rd and 4th quarters 2018 in the amount of \$3,151.04, will be waived due to the exemption.
