

TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD

RESOLUTION 20-172

AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY- DERRICOTT

WHEREAS, Deborah Anne Derricott, property owner of 14 Briarwood Lane, Block 701 Lot 9.06, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

WHEREAS, due to her disability, has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began on August 20, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the property taxes for the 3rd quarter 2020 in the amount of \$2,641.55, will be prorated to provide a tax refund in the amount of \$1,205.93 from the effective date of the tax exemption, and the taxes for the 4th quarter 2020 and the 1st and 2nd quarters 2021 in the amount of \$7,361.59 will be waived.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 15th day of October 2020, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$306,000 and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of August 20, 2020; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is authorized to provide a tax refund in the amount of \$1,205.93 from the effective date of the tax exemption, and waive the taxes for the 4th quarter 2020 and the 1st and 2nd quarters 2021 in the amount of \$7,361.59, due to the 100% disability exemption.
