## **RESOLUTION 20-210**

## AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY- POLLOCK

**WHEREAS,** Howard K. Pollock, property owner of 10 Weymouth Place, Block 2501 Lot 43, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

**WHEREAS,** due to his disability, has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began on January 1, 2020; and

**WHEREAS,** the property taxes will be refunded from the effective date of the tax exemption for the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2020 in the amount of \$5,454.39, and the taxes for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarters 2021 in the amount of \$2,727.20 will be waived.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of December 2020, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$177,100 and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of January 1, 2020; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tax Collector is authorized to refund the property taxes for the  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$ ,  $3^{rd}$  and  $4^{th}$  quarter 2020 in the amount of \$5,454.39 and waive the property taxes for the  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  quarters in the amount of \$2,727.20 and the balance of 2021 when the tax rate is struck, due to the 100% disability exemption.
