RESOLUTION 21-101

**AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A
WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY- PAUL M. SZABO**

WHEREAS, Paul M. Szabo, property owner of 5 Truman Street, Block 820 Lot 22, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

WHEREAS, due to their disability, has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began on February 24, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the property taxes for the 2nd quarter in the amount of \$111.93 be waived and 3rd & 4th quarter to be waived when the tax amount is determined.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 20th day of May 2021, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$181,800. and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of February 24, 2021; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is authorized to waive the property taxes for the 2nd quarter in the amount of \$111.93 and the balance of 2021 when the tax amount is determined, due to the 100% disability exemption.
