Spoltore, Clerk, be and is hereby authorized and permitted to establish a Petty Cash Fund in the amount not to exceed \$50.00 pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:5-21. Said Petty Cash Fund will be used by such office or department to pay claims for small miscellaneous expenses.
- 2. Roy J. Spoltore, Clerk, having custody of the Fund be bonded in an amount not less than \$1,000.00 and will maintain said Fund in accordance with the Laws and regulations governing its operation.
- 2. The Treasurer and CFO is hereby directed and authorized to fund said petty cash fund account in the amount of \$50.00.
