RESOLUTION 21-182

AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY- STEWARD

WHEREAS, Steward, Philip., property owner of 47 Eisenhower Drive, Block 820 Lot 1, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

WHEREAS, due to his disability, has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began on March 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the property taxes for the 3rd quarter 2021 in the amount of \$130.12, and 4th quarter 2021 in the amount \$ 130.12 to be waived and the taxes for the 1st and 2nd quarters 2022 in the amount of \$251.72 will be waived.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 4th day of November 2021, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$236,700.00 and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of March 31, 2021; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is authorized to waive the property taxes for the 1st and 2nd quarters in the amount of \$251.72 and the balance of 2022 when the tax rate is struck, due to the 100% disability exemption.
