RESOLUTION 21-55

**AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A
WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY- IMES, SANDRA LYNN**

WHEREAS, Imes, Sandra Lynn., property owner of 224 Rosenhayn Avenue, Block 2701 Lot 13.02, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

WHEREAS, due to the disability, she has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes her property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began on January 8, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the property taxes for the 1st quarter 2021 in the amount of \$3,143.56, will be will be waived from the effective date of the tax exemption, and the taxes for the 2nd quarter 2021 in the amount of \$3,163.02 will be waived and the 3rd and 4th quarters 2021 will be waived when the tax rate is struck.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 4th day of February 2021, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$385,300. and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of January 8, 2021; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is authorized to waive the property taxes for the 1st and 2nd quarters in the amount of \$6,306.58 and the 3rd and 4th quarters of 2021 will be waived when the tax rate is struck, due to the 100% disability exemption.
