APPROVING PUBLIC FACILITIES GRANT MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Township of Upper Deerfield will apply for up to \$400,000 in Fiscal Year 2023 CDBG funds for a Public Facilities project for a Phase 5 project to eliminate architectural barriers that hinder access by disabled/handicapped persons at the Seabrook Recreation & Sports Complex and Sunset Lake Park and/or an emergency generator for the Township’s Senior Center; and

WHEREAS, the NJ Department of Community Affairs requires Upper Deerfield Township to prepare a Grant Management Plan to define project staffing and project activities; and

WHEREAS, the NJ Department of Community Affairs requires Upper Deerfield Township to officially adopt its Grant Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Township has prepared a Grant Management Plan for its Fiscal Year 2023 Public Facilities project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield adopts the Grant Management Plan prepared by Blauer Associates for the Fiscal Year 2023 Public Facilities project.
