

RESOLUTION 22-188

AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY- EVANOSKI

WHEREAS, Evanoski, David C., property owner of 160 Center Road, Block 401 Lot 3, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

WHEREAS, due to his disability, has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began on July 22, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the property taxes for the 3rd quarter 2022 in the prorated amount of \$ 1,756.74 to be refunded, and the property taxes for the 4th quarter taxes in 2022 in the amount \$ 2,291.38 to be waived and the taxes for the 1st and 2nd quarters 2023 in the amount of \$ 4,592.69 will be waived.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 17th day of November 2022, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$ 126,000.00 for the balance of 2022, and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of January 1, 2023; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is authorized to refund the prorated taxes for the 3rd quarter from July 22, 2022, in the amount of \$ 1,756.74, and to waive the property taxes for the 4th quarter of 2022 in the amount of \$ 2,291.38 and waive the 1st and 2nd quarters 2023 in the amount of \$ 4,592.69, due to the 100% disability exemption.
