## **RESOLUTION 22-99**

## AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY- BURGOS

**WHEREAS,** Francisco Burgos, property owner of 14 Oak Hill Drive, Block 1501 Lot 21.01, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

**WHEREAS,** due to his disability, has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began on January 1, 2022; and

**WHEREAS,** the property taxes for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2022 in the amount of \$ 2,157.94 to be refunded, and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2022 in the amount of \$ 2,157.93 to be refunded and the taxes for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter to be waived when the tax rate is struck.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Township Committee of Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 2022, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$258,900 and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of January 1, 2022; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tax Collector is authorized to waive the property taxes for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarters in the amount of \$ 4,315.87 and the balance of 2022 when the tax rate is struck, due to the 100% disability exemption.
