RESOLUTION 22-99

AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY- BURGOS

WHEREAS, Francisco Burgos,, property owner of 14 Oak Hill Drive, Block 1501 Lot 21.01, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

WHEREAS, due to his disability, has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began on January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the property taxes for the 1st quarter 2022 in the amount of \$ 2,157.94 to be refunded, and 2nd quarter 2022 in the amount of \$ 2,157.93 to be refunded and the taxes for the 3rd quarter and 4th quarter to be waived when the tax rate is struck.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 16th day of June 2022, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$258,900 and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of January 1, 2022; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is authorized to waive the property taxes for the 1st and 2nd quarters in the amount of \$ 4,315.87 and the balance of 2022 when the tax rate is struck, due to the 100% disability exemption.
