

TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD

RESOLUTION 23-158

AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY- DENIGHT

WHEREAS, Michael DeNight, property owner of 12 Sunset Lake Road, Block 1704 Lot 11, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

WHEREAS, due to his disability, has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began on August 3rd 2023; and

WHEREAS, the property taxes for the 3rd quarter 2023 in the prorated amount of \$ 688.56 to be refunded, and 4th quarter 2023 taxes in the amount of \$1,365.80 be waived and the 1st quarter and 2nd quarter 2024 taxes in the amount of \$2,738.70 be waived.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 19th day of October 2023, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$62,800.00 and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of August 3rd 2023; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is authorized to refund the property taxes for the 3rd quarter 2023 in the prorated amount of \$540.90 and waive the 4th quarter 2023 taxes in the amount of \$1,365.80 and waive the 1st quarter and 2nd quarter 2024 taxes in the amount of \$2,738.70, due to the 100% disability exemption.
