

**TOWNSHIP OF UPPER DEERFIELD**

**RESOLUTION 23-182**

**AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A  
WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY- MINTZ**

**WHEREAS**, Robert J. Mintz, property owner of 251 Landis Avenue Road, Block 2501 Lot 101, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

**WHEREAS**, due to his disability, has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, the approved disability began on September 6, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the property taxes for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2023 in the prorated amount of \$343.68 and the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2023 in the amount of \$1,288.79 to be refunded. The first and second quarters for 2024 will be waived in the amount of \$2,560.75.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Township Committee of Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 16<sup>th</sup> day of November 2023, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$49,100.00 and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of September 6<sup>th</sup> 2023; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tax Collector is authorized to refund the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2023 taxes in the prorated amount of \$343.68 and the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2023 in the amount of \$1,288.79 and waive the property taxes for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2024 in the amount of \$2,560.75, due to the 100% disability exemption.
