RESOLUTION 24-31

APPOINTING PROSECUTOR AND CONFLICT PROSECUTOR FOR THE CUMBERLAND SALEM REGIONAL MUNICIPAL COURT

WHEREAS, there exists the need for the "Professional Services" of a PROSECUTOR FOR CUMBERLAND SALEM REGIONAL MUNICIPAL COURT, to be retained by the Township for the performance of legal services and related duties associated therewith as directed by the authorized representatives of the Cumberland Salem Regional Municipal Court Committee, as more specifically set forth in the Professional Services Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Cumberland Salem Regional Municipal Court Committee has recommended that the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield appoint Christopher Ross, Esquire as Prosecutor for Cumberland Salem Regional Municipal Court, for a one-year term to expire December 31, 2024 with compensation pursuant to the Professional Service Contract for the year 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Cumberland Salem Regional Municipal Court Committee has recommended that the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield appoint Jacci Vigilante, Esquire as Conflict Prosecutor for Cumberland Salem Regional Municipal Court, for a one-year term to expire December 31, 2024 with compensation pursuant to the Professional Service Contract for the year 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. That the allegations of the preamble hereto are incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- 2. That Christopher Ross, Esq. of the Vigilante Law Firm of Mullica Hill, New Jersey, an attorney authorized to practice law by the Supreme Court of the State of New Jersey, be appointed Cumberland Salem Regional Municipal Court Prosecutor for the year 2024, to perform professional services ordinarily provided by a prosecutor, and shall receive compensation in accordance with terms of the contract on file in the Clerk's office.
- 3. That Jacci Vigilante, Esq. an attorney authorized to practice law by the Supreme Court of the State of New Jersey, be appointed Cumberland Salem Regional Municipal Court Conflict Prosecutor for the year 2024, to perform professional services ordinarily provided by a prosecutor, and shall receive compensation in accordance with terms of the contract on file in the Clerk's office.
- 4. That the aforesaid contract is awarded pursuant to competitive bidding as a "Professional Service" under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law because N.J.S.A.40A:11-5 states that no local unit shall be required to advertise for bids for services rendered or performed by a person authorized by law to practice a recognized profession and whose practice is regulated by law, or to advertise for bids for services which are of such a qualitative nature as will not reasonably permit the drawing of

specifications or the receipt of competitive bids, all of which classification the aforesaid contract falls within.

- 5. The professional fees contained within the aforementioned contract are included within the temporary budget and the continuation of any potential additional fees for the year will be included within the adopted 2024 budget to be certified by the Chief Financial Officer upon adoption of the 2024 budget.
- 6. The Business Entity Disclosure Certification shall be placed on file with this Resolution.
- 7. That a copy of the specific items pertaining to the award of this contract shall be published in a Notice of Award in the Daily Journal as required by law within ten (10) days of the Resolution authorizing same; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Christopher Ross, Esq. and Jacci Vigilante, Esq. of the Vigilante Law Firm in a form satisfactory to the Township Solicitor of the Township of Upper Deerfield on behalf of the Cumberland Salem Regional Municipal Court Committee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper Deerfield that this professional service agreement is awarded pursuant to and in compliance with the provisions of Pay to Play legislation, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4, et seq.
