## **RESOLUTION 24-71**

## AUTHORIZING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO ADJUST TAXES FOR A WARTIME SERVICE-CONNECTED 100% DISABILITY- KNIGHT

**WHEREAS,** Normand Bernard Knight, property owner of 7 Krysta Court, Block 1110.01, Lot 4, has been certified by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs as having a wartime service-connected 100% disability; and

**WHEREAS,** due to his disability, has been approved for a total tax exemption under N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, L 1948, C259 which changes his property assessment classification from a 2 to a 15F exempt status and the collection of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the approved disability began on Jan 1, 2024; and

**WHEREAS,** the property taxes paid for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2024 in the amount of \$2,399.09 be refunded and the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2024 in the amount of \$2,399.08 be waived and the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2024 to be waived when the tax rate is struck.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Township Committee of Upper Deerfield Township, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey on this 7<sup>th</sup> day of March 2024, determines that the assessed value of the property should be exempted in the amount of \$286,800.00 and the property be reclassified as 15F exempt with an effective date of January 1, 2024; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tax Collector is authorized to refund 2,399.09 for  $1^{st}$  quarter payment and to waive the property taxes for  $2^{nd}$  quarter in the amount of \$2,399.08 and waive the  $3^{rd}$  and  $4^{th}$  quarter taxes when the tax rate is struck, due to the 100% disability exemption.
